

Climate Change

St Mewan Parish Council have signed up to action on Climate Change in accordance with the Cornwall Council Declaration of a Climate Emergency and we have declared our own Climate Emergency.

The Parish Council wishes to pursue the actions outlined in our <u>DRAFT PLAN `LIVING</u> <u>DOCUMENT'</u>.

As climate change is something that affects us all, it would be totally wrong for the Parish Council to dictate to everyone in the Parish what is going to be done.

This is a Community Activity and as such there should be **Input, Influence & Ideas** from everyone, especially young people who will be the future inheritors of what we do now.

The plan is an open '*Living Document'*, which means that it will change as the parish ideas are brought on board. The latest copy will always be on this section of the website.

It is currently a document of less than 20 pages, but as **YOUR** vision expands so will the document.

A copy will be placed in each of the village shops so that those without the internet can browse it.

As the Parish Councillor responsible for Climate Change (that doesn't mean I caused it!) I would like to form a Community Action Group to move this forward. It would start off informally as a group, or perhaps village groups with an interest in everything relating to Climate Change.

The groups can look at the issues and what we can do about improving the way forwards.
