<u>Nominations</u>

Any member of the public who is a registered elector in the Parish of St Mewan may submit one or more nominations to the Parish Council, to be received no later than Monday 29th February 2024.

Self-nominations or nominations by close relatives are acceptable.

Nominations are acceptable by using the form attached, by letter or email giving the same information, whichever is easiest for you. Up to three individuals or groups will be honoured. Information contained on the nomination form will be anonymised before all Parish Councillors judge the winners.

Award Ceremony

The Annual Awards will be presented at the Annual Parish Assembly on Wednesday 10th April 2024 in St Marks Church Hall, Sticker.

<u>Awards</u>

The winners will be presented with a framed certificate and £25.00 for their chosen charity, in addition to The White Pyramid in Trewoon, Polgooth Inn and Hewas Inn in Sticker who are kindly sponsoring the winner's meal.
