- i. Application PA26/O4655 Proposal Demolition of existing dwelling and erection of two new dwellings Location 2 Westbridge Road Trewoon St Austell Cornwall Applicant Mr M Foster Grid Ref 199441 / Discussion took place, and associated documents were viewed together with the St Mewan Neighbourhood Development Plan and Design Code.  
It was **RESOLVED** to **OBJECT** to the application as follows:

Members with local knowledge considers the site unsuitable for the scale and density of the proposed development. The proposal for two dwellings represents an overdevelopment with surrounding highway conditions and limited access.

There is inadequate parking provision. The proposal does not provide sufficient parking to meet the needs of two dwellings. This is likely to result in additional vehicles being parked on the surrounding roads, further exacerbating existing access and highway problems and potentially creating obstruction and safety concerns. A number of reports have recently been submitted to MP Noah Law that vehicles are regularly being left on roads and in residential areas, causing obstruction and creating difficulties for residents.

The proposed access is considered inadequate and raises significant highway safety concerns. The site has extremely poor access onto an A-road subject to a 30-mph speed limit. Introducing additional residential traffic at this location would create an unacceptable risk to motorists, pedestrians and other road users, particularly given the restricted visibility and constrained nature of the access.

Access from Trevanion Road is extremely narrow. The restricted width of the road/access raises serious concerns regarding the ability of vehicles to safely enter and leave the site, particularly larger vehicles, delivery vehicles, refuse collection vehicles and emergency services. The vehicular access/egress for the properties in Trewoon is via a footpath which will pose a hazard to those using it, particularly schoolchildren who are likely to use it when walking to and from school. The proposal would place additional pressure on an already severely constrained access.

The impact on the existing highway network should evidence that vehicles can safely access and egress the site without creating additional hazards or inconvenience for existing residents and road users. Members with local knowledge have serious doubts that this can be achieved.

Gold Footpath 25/1 has not been properly acknowledged or addressed in the planning application.

Location Land North Of Mount Pleasant Farm Trelowth Road Polgooth Cornwall Applicant Mr Anthony Minear Grid Ref 199220 / 50610 Discussion took place, and associated documents were viewed together with the St Mewan Neighbourhood Development Plan and Design Code.  
It was **RESOLVED** to **OBJECT** to part of the application as follows as it does not comply with the approved Cornwall Council Design Code.  
Applicant does not appear to have consulted the Design Code which refers to parking, amenity space, clothes drying, social interaction and letterbox height etc. It is disappointing that no affordable housing has been considered. Prop. Cllr Mrs Tarbox , sec Cllr Williams. **Action: Clerk**
