## St Mewan School, traffic congestion and road safety and yellow lines.

I had a meeting on the 17<sup>th</sup> June with the Highways Manager and there is a highways scheme in development they have informed me the construction works will take place during the summer school holidays. 2025.

This will include extending the double yellow lines outside St Mewan School, renewing existing lines and to formalise a parking bay to blue badge holders only.

## Resident enquiry CAS-21570-M4G2S9,

I submitted a casework assist enquiry on behalf of a local resident in the parish and I have chased this up with the appropriate team. The latest update is that the Highways Manager will arrange an inspection of the trees, to understand the concerns raised.

If following an inspection, Cornwall Council does not consider it appropriate to undertake/fund any highway tree works for highway safety reasons, property owners have a legal right in common law to remove all overhanging growth extending into their land (back to the boundary line only). If this is a course of action a property owner intends to follow, Arboriculture advice is recommended, and employment of a competent contractor. A person may be held liable if any pruning works undertaken render a tree unsafe or cause its premature decline.

#### Hewas Water Sticker speeding Issues.

I've met with the highways manager and she has agreed to a site visit to investigate the concerns of the local people. This is scheduled for 18th July, 2:30pm.

Is there already a community speed watch group?

This is a really good way of collecting evidence. The police can then take action if there is a persistent driver and evidence is gathered.

## **Central Planning Committee - Trecarne PA25/00819**

I attended the committee meeting on 30<sup>th</sup> June and I read out a statement regarding this application. When it came to the vote I objected the application, but unfortunately planning permission was agreed. This is the first phase of PIP and I as requested a condition for a draft construction management plan that shows how construction
